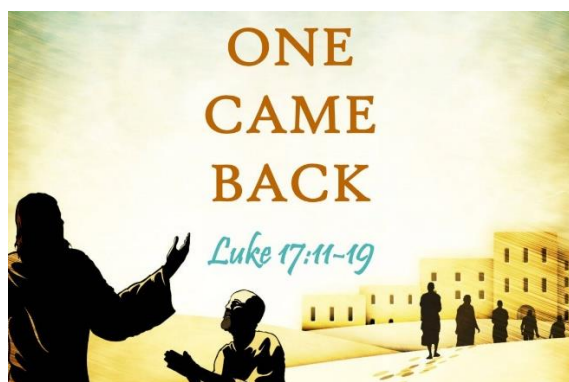




WELCOME TO THE PARISH OF East Lake Macquarie
