Confirmation

The Sacrament of Confirmation is the second part of Christian Baptism. Before confirmation by the Bishop the candidate renews the promises of baptism and affirms Christian faith in the words of the ancient baptismal creed.



Young candidates for confirmation are usually aged eleven or twelve years.
