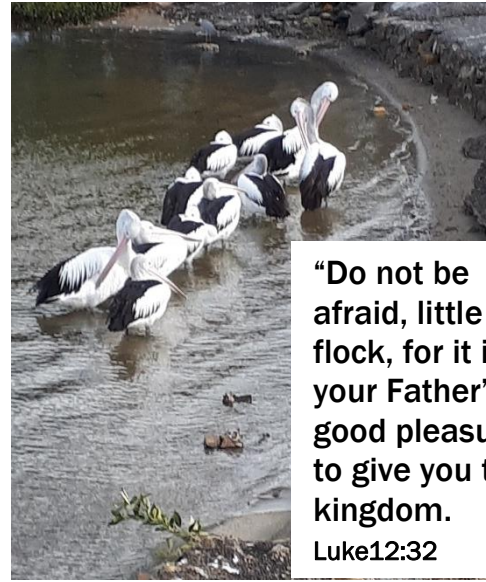
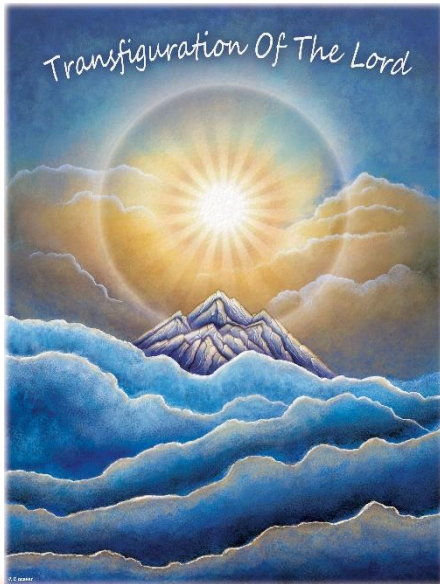

Tea and coffee are available.

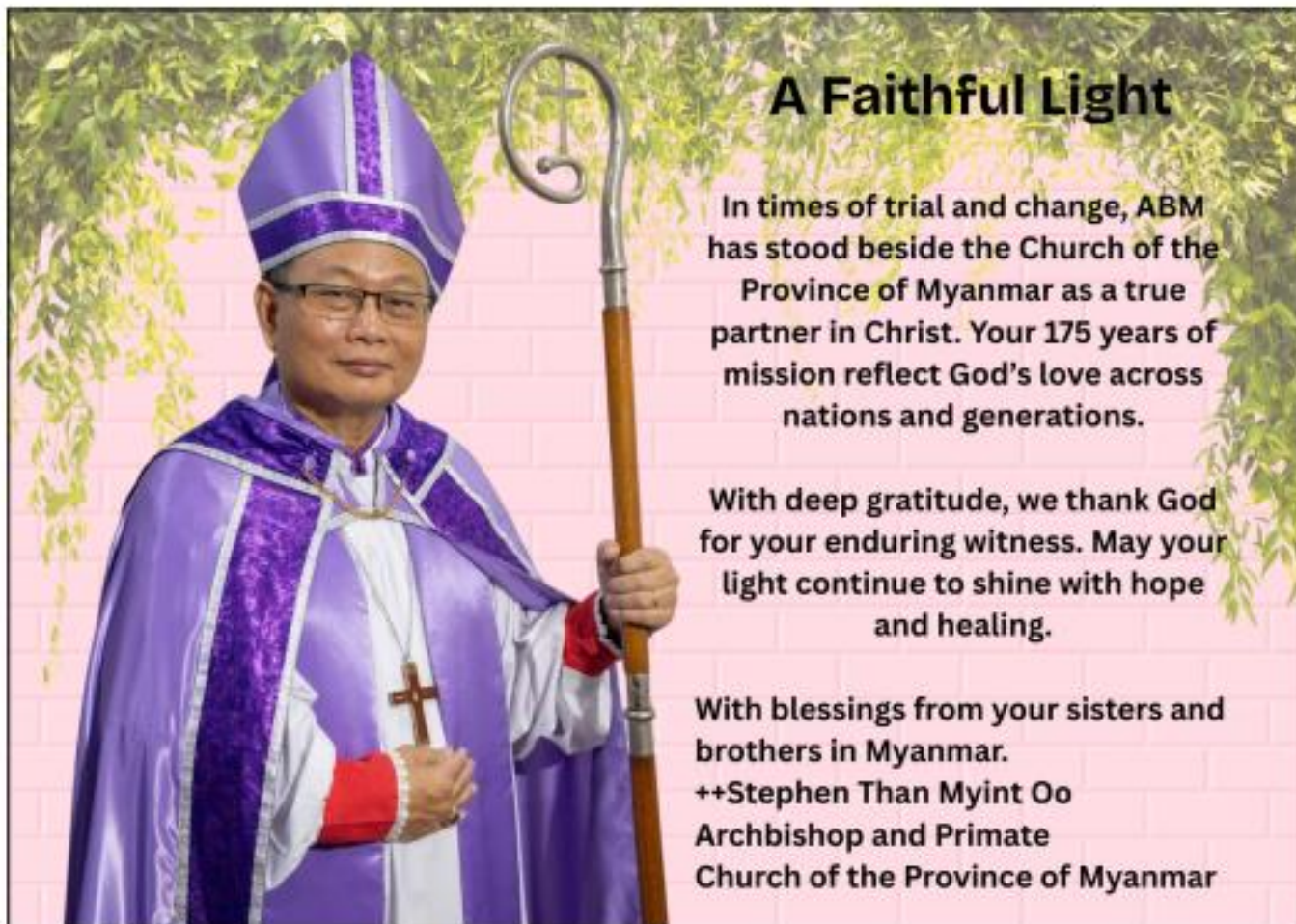
