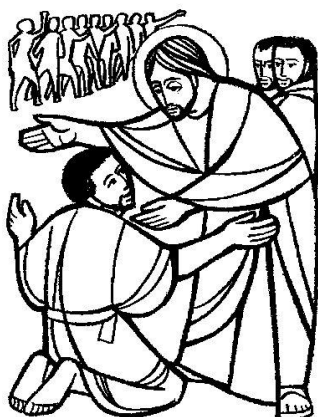

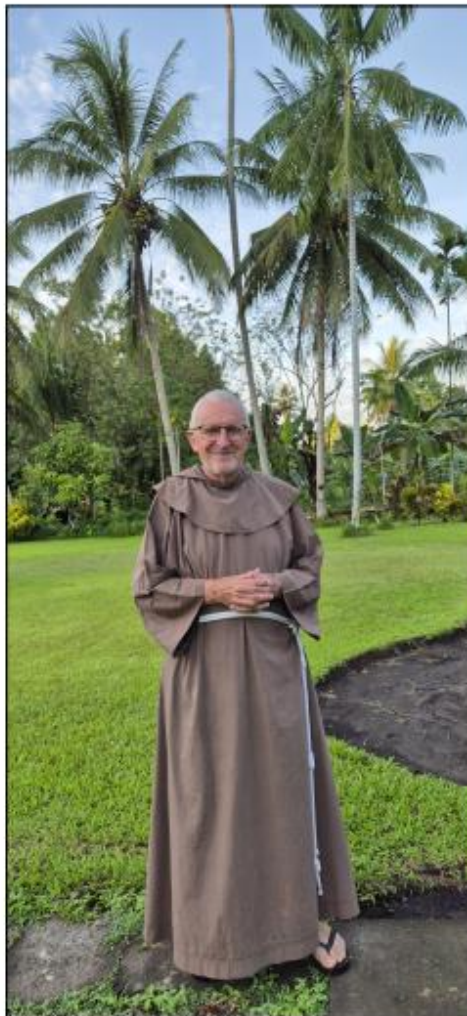

Many of our older brothers knew and worked with ABM missionaries in PNG, 'back in the day'. We work under different arrangements, different structures – but at grassroots level we are all people who have a passion for the gospel and for helping build up local church ministries and programmes.
